- 3. Recommendation of panel of judges from the academe. Each category should be represented (Spelling and Grammar, Math, Science and Araling Panlipunan)

4. Announcement to schools of the details of the Final event and other updates

5. Announcement of the coordination meeting on January 23, 12noon, at Max's Restaurant along National Road. We request each school to send a representative.

Munting Henyo Quiz Bee

CONTEST RULES AND MECHANICS

- 1. All Grade 5 and 6 students of public elementary schools in Muntinlupa are entitled to join the contest.
- 2. The guiz bee is open to teams, consisting of 2 students and 1 coach.
- 3. Questions will cover academic, spelling and grammar, history and Muntinlupa general information.
- 4. There will be 3 stages of the competition: Qualifying stage to be held individually at all public schools and the Semi-finals and Finals to be held at the Muntinlupa Sports Complex with the Finals as the culminating event.
- 5. Each consists of three (3) rounds easy, average and difficult, which will be composed of 10 questions per round. For each round, every correct answer shall be given five (5), ten (10) and fifteen (15) points, respectively.
- 6. Contestants will be given ten (10) seconds for the easy round, fifteen (15) seconds for the average round and twenty (20) seconds for the difficult round to answer the questions.
- 7. Answers must be written in the answer boards to be provided by the facilitators.
- 8. Questions for the previous number should be raised before the Quiz Master proceeds to the next question; otherwise, it will not be entertained.
- 9. A clincher question shall be given to break a tie, if there is any. The first one who got the correct answer will be declared a winner.
- 10. Personal data and school affiliation of the participants shall not be available to the judges to ensure impartially of their decisions. Numbers will be assigned to the participants.

Non-winning student participants who reached the Semi-Final Rounds will receive a medal and gift pack.

Non-winning student participants of the Qualifying Rounds will receive certificates of participation.

CONTEST RULES AND MECHANICS

THEME: Isang Siglo ng Lakas, Talino't Buhay

- 1. The contest is open to all public elementary students in Muntinlupa and will be held together with the qualifying round of the Munting Henyo Quiz Bee in the schools.
- 2. Each participating school may have up to 8 participants.
- 3. The facilitator will read the mechanics 15 minutes before the start of the contest.
- 4. The topic/theme will be given right after reading the mechanics for the category.
- 5. White illustration board will be provided. Contestants should bring their own drawing and coloring materials.
- 6. The criteria for judging:

Relevance to the theme	40%
Originality	30%
Creativity	20%
Overall Impact	10%
Total	100%

- 7. Participants will be given two (2) hours to finish their piece.
- 8. All entries will be displayed at the Muntinlupa Sports Complex during the Munting Henyo Quiz Bee.
- 9. Winners will be announced on the day of the Munting Henyo Quiz Bee.

Munting Henyo CHEER DANCE

CONTEST RULES AND MECHANICS

THEME: Isang Siglo ng Lakas, Talino't Buhay

I. GENERAL

- 1. The following rules and regulations are to be in effect for all practices and the competition proper.
- 2. All teams must be supervised during the practices and competition by a qualified and knowledgeable coach.
- 3. All participants agree to conduct themselves in a manner displaying good sportsmanship throughout the event.
- 4. Coaches should recognize the squad's ability level and should limit activities accordingly.
- 5. All participants must adopt a comprehensive conditioning and strength-building program.
- 6. All coaches, directors and advisors must have an emergency action plan in the event of an injury.
- 7. Teams must have 10 to 15 dancers, from Grades 5 and 6 to perform the dance.
- 8. Audience representatives/cheerers from the school must have a minimum of 30 members and maximum of 50 members.
- 9. Participants with any medical conditions should present a medical clearance from a certified doctor. The organizers will not be liable for any undeclared medical conditions.
- 10. The cheerers will do their cheer on the audience platform while the dancers will perform at the center of the complex.
- 11. Each team will be given a maximum of three (3) minutes for the routine. The quiz bee school representative will be given 10 seconds to introduce themselves and their school (Quiz Bee representative states name, introduces school). Timer starts upon the first yell/cheer, dance movement, start of music, or whichever come first.
- 12. An appropriate warm-up routing should precede all cheer dancing activities.
- 13. Any team member who may acquire injury will not be allowed to continue the routine. A substitution may be made as long as he/she falls under the qualifications.
- 14. Any team proven in violation of the rules and regulations will be automatically disqualified from the
- 15. Should recorded music be part of the routine, file must be handed over to the organizers on or before February 8, Wednesday, on a properly labeled CD player and USB in MP3 format.

PROPS, COSTUMES & STUNTS

- 1. Costumes and props shall be provided by the cheer dance group participating. Economical and creative costumes and props are encouraged.
- 2. Only moves and materials that are stable and safe will be part of the routine, hence no pyramids, stunts and tumbling will be included.
- 3. Props must be handled with care in taking in and out of the competition area.
- Athletic footwear is required. Wearing socks, tights or other slippery foot covering is not allowed.
- 5. Wearing of any jewelry is prohibited.

- 6. The use of mini trampolines, springboards and other height-increasing apparatus is prohibited.
- 7. Costumes and props shall be provided by the cheer dance group.
- 8. Glitters and sequins on bodies, costumes or props are not allowed as these may pose danger if detached and left on the floor.
- 9. The following are prohibited at any point of the routine: liquids, flammable materials, confetti, powder, firecrackers and any hard or heavy materials that may destroy the gym's floor during entry or exit.
- 10. All groups are given 3 minutes to clear up the area with all materials utilized after the routine.

11. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

- Choreography and Synchronization 30%
- Overall Relevance to the Theme 15%
- Cheer Group Cheers 20%
- Economical and Creative Costume and Props 10%
- Music 10%
- Overall Impact 15%

*With the following penalties for violations:

- · Not within allotted time- 10 points deduction
- Every 15 seconds over allotted time- 2 points deduction
 (A buzzer will be sounded once the group has exceeded the allowable time and every 15 seconds thereafter)
- · Stepping out of performance area 2 pts. deduction per person
- Costume, props and stunts violations DISQUALIFICATION
