GRADE VI TEACHERS ON THE K TO 12 CURRICULUM**

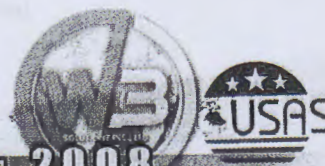
This Office announces the screening of potential trainers for the Mass Training of Grade 6 teachers on the K - 12 Curriculum.

- b. be a learning area specialist or have taught the learning area and grade level for at least five (5) years
- c. be recommended by the school head / EPS
- d. have had experience as a trainer or facilitator
- e. have attended previous DepEd training programs related to the K to 12 Curriculum
- f. be computer literate
- g. be physically fit
- h. have a good command of English and Filipino language





- k. have been evaluated at least VS as learning facilitator / trainer for sessions handled by DepEd

School Heads must submit the names of their recommended trainer/s to the SDO Attn: CID Chief on February 14, 2017, and advise them to bring their credentials (portfolio) during the interview.
