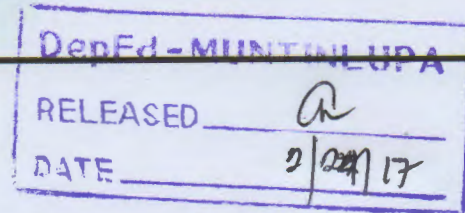



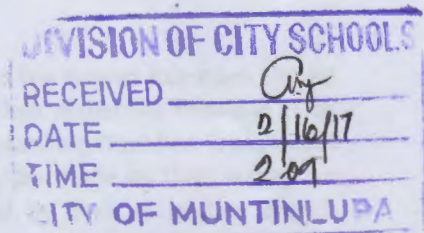

**GUIDELINES FOR MOST OUTSTANDING RIZAL RED CROSS YOUTH LEADERS
(MORRCYL)**

RATIONALE:

The Philippine Red Cross recruits and trains youth volunteers through the various programs and activities of its Red Cross Youth (RCY) service. The RCY organizes youth councils in schools and communities to allow members to plan and implement Red Cross activities as an organized group. The success of each RCY Council depends on the leadership of its officers and the support of each member. To encourage all RCY members to be actively involved in all RCY programs, activities and projects the RCY gives recognition to its outstanding volunteers. The Red Cross Youth believes that by recognizing outstanding RCY members, all Red Cross Youth Councils will be inspired to organize RCY activities and implement RCY programs to achieve distinction.

The 2017 Search consists of three (3) awards. First, the Ten (10) Most Active Red Cross Youth Member Award, is nominated by the Adviser and awarded in the Council Level. Secondly, the Gawad Kabataan Award, is nominated by the Adviser to represent the Council in the Branch Level. And lastly, the Most Outstanding Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader (for Senior, College and Community RCY) or the Most Promising Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader (for Junior Red Cross), has passed the requirements set by the Gawad Kabataan and is nominated by their respective CSR-RCY to represent the Branch in the Chapter Level.

The award shall be bestowed to active Red Cross Youth volunteers under the jurisdiction of Rizal Chapter. The recipients should have also contributed in the management and sustenance of their respective Red Cross Youth Councils.

OBJECTIVE:

Recognize active and deserving Red Cross Youth volunteers who have achieved the required level of excellence in service delivery and made an impact in their respective school or community through their active involvement with the PRC and other organizations, while at the same time maintaining an outstanding academic standing.

NOMINATION FOR THE AWARDS

Nominations for the 10 Most Active Red Cross Youth Members and the Gawad Kabataan should only be made by their respective Red Cross Youth Adviser duly signed by their respective Principal / OIC (School) or Barangay Chairman (Community). Nominations for the Most Outstanding Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader and the Most Promising Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader should only be made by their respective Chapter Service Representative for Red Cross Youth duly acknowledged by their respective Branch Administrators / OIC.

QUALIFICATIONS OF PROSPECTIVE NOMINEES:

- A bonafide Red Cross Youth Member.
- A Filipino resident with good humanitarian values and character.
- Can express him/herself fluently in English and/or Filipino.
- Active in the service delivery of the different PRC Services especially in Red Cross Youth for at least 2 years.
- Must not be convicted in any form of crime.
- Belongs to a recognized, active and sustainable RCY Council and has participated in various Red Cross activities of the Rizal Chapter.

LIST OF AWARDS:

1. **10 Most Active Red Cross Youth Members** – council level award nominated by the RCY Adviser for Junior Red Cross and Senior Red Cross Youth members
2. **Gawad Kabataan Award** – branch level award nominated by the RCY Adviser for Junior, Senior, College, and Community Red Cross Youth members
3. **Most Promising Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader** – chapter level award nominated by the Branch CSR-RCY for Junior Red Cross (Elementary) members
4. **Most Outstanding Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader** – chapter level award nominated by the Branch CSR-RCY for Senior, College and Community Red Cross Youth members

REQUIREMENTS FOR 10 MOST ACTIVE RED CROSS YOUTH MEMBERS:

1. Completely filled up and signed Official Nomination Form
2. Letter of Recommendation from the RCY Adviser
3. Photocopy of LDP Certificate/s (YVOC, LFC, BLT)
4. Original Certificate of Good Moral Character

REQUIREMENTS FOR GAWAD KABATAAN 2017:

1. Completely filled up and signed Official Nomination Form
2. Letter of Recommendation from the RCY Adviser
3. Photocopy of LDP Certificate/s (YVOC, LFC, BLT)
4. Original Certificate of Good Moral Character (School) or Barangay Clearance (Community)
5. Photocopy of School Report Card / Transcript of Records
6. Photocopies of Training / Activity Certificates attended by the Nominee (enclosed in a folder / clear book)
7. 2 pcs. 2x2 ID Picture
8. RCY Form 006 (Volunteer's Accomplishment Report Form)
9. Essay
 - In English or Tagalog (but not both)
 - At least 300 but no more than 1,000 words
 - On-the-spot (written)
 - Theme: **"How can the youth help the Red Cross?"**

SCREENING & SELECTION PROCESS:

There will be three (3) levels of selection:

1. **Council Level.** The Red Cross Youth Adviser selects and nominates 10 Most Active Red Cross Youth Members and Gawad Kabataan only. Nominees will then be given a copy of the Official Nomination Form from the RCY Adviser and nominees must submit the requirements on-time.

2. **Branch Level.** All nominations with complete requirements received by the respective Chapter Service Representative for Red Cross Youth (RCY) will initially screened. Nominees who are qualified based on the requirements and initial criteria will be notified for an interview with the Branch-level Board of Judges. Those who have over-achieved the initial criteria will receive the Gawad Kabataan Award and also proceed to the next level.
3. **Chapter Level.** The finalists from the different branches will be announced and notified for an interview with the Chapter-level Board of Judges. The Most Outstanding Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader or Most Promising Rizal Red Cross Youth Leader will be selected as a result of the interview including knowledge, skills and attitude.

SUBMISSION OF NOMINATIONS

All nominations must be received by the Secretariat Committee on or before **February 24, 2017, 5:00PM**. Requirements must be submitted in a long brown envelope with your name and to their respective branches.
