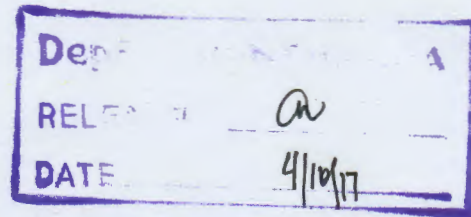

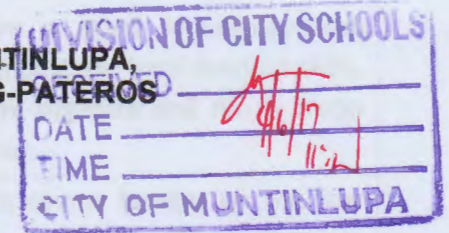

BASIC TRAINING and AGE-LEVEL SPECIALIZATION	MAY 3-5	TEACHERS, other ADULTS who are interested and willing to organize GSP TROOPS	Php3,500.00 Tent-living	It aims to: educate on the basics and understanding of Girl Scouting, its aims, ideals, program structure, policies and standards, ways of work. Stimulate the acceptance of the Girl Scout Promise and Law.
2. CAMPERS PERMIT (CPC)	MAY 3-6	TEACHERS or TROOP LEADERS who have already taken the GSP Basic Training and Outdoor Leadership Courses	Php3,800.00 Tent-living	This course will allow Troop Leaders to plan, organize and run Camps other than her Troop, with at least 80 to 120 campers. This is also a must-course for Troop Leaders who wish to be Credentialed GSP Trainers.
3. DISTRICT COMMITTEE (DC) and DISTRICT FIELD ADVISERS (DFA)/ COORDINATORS ROUNDTABLE	MAY 3-5	GSP FIELD ADVISERS /COORDINATOR, DISTRICT COMMITTEE MEMBERS	Php3,500.00	DC is the "little Council" in every City/Municipality thus, its members must know how to go about its role in the movement while the DFA/Coordinator are the "little Executive".

4. OUTDOOR LEADERSHIP (OLC)	MAY 5-7	TEACHERS or TROOP LEADERS (those with GSP Troops) who have already taken the GSP Basic Course.	Php3,500.00 Tent-living	At the end of the course the participants should be able to have a good knowledge and demonstrate basic outdoor skills, plan, organize and run a Troop Camp.
5. STAR HOLIDAY	MAY 5-7	TEACHERS / TROOP LEADERS who are handling Star Troops and intending to organize Star Troops.	Php3,500.00	This course focuses on the Star Scout Program. The participants will learn the skills essential in running outdoor events for the said age level.
6. BASIC ADMINISTRATION	MAY 6-7	PRINCIPALS, SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS/ DIRECTORS, DISTRICT COMMITTEE MEMBERS, OTHER ADULTS	Php3,500.00	This course is intended to give the participants a deeper understanding and appreciation of the ways of work of the Movement and to stimulate more support and cooperation from them.

Additional things to bring for CPC and OLC are:


- 15 pcs. Bamboos 1 yard x 1 inch.
