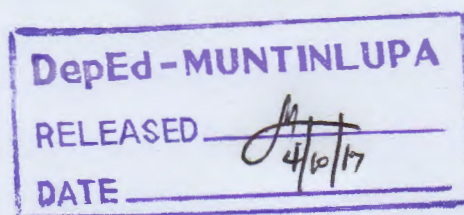

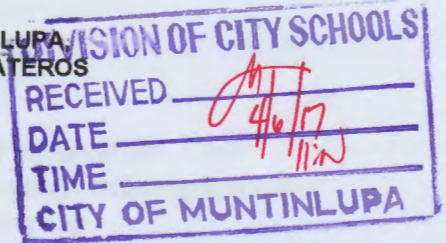

Girl Scouts are expected to learn and know more life skills to live up to its motto "Be Prepared" which can only be achieved through continuous training from their Troop Leaders, Trainers and allied agencies that shares same ideal with the Movement. With reference to this, we are offering Summer Training Courses on APRIL 17-20, 2017 at DELA SALLE SANTIAGO-ZOBEL, AYALA-ALABANG VILLAGE, MUNTINLUPA CITY as follows:

1. **GIRLS' CAMP PERMIT COURSE** intended for our GIRLS who wish to have a deeper knowledge and appreciation of nature, their environment, living life simply in the out-of-doors (camping), safely but still having clean fun, lead her Patrol to camping.
 For: Juniors (Grade VI), Senior and Cadet Girl Scouts Php1,200.00
2. **SERVICE AUXILLIARY VOLUNTEERS for EMERGENCY and RELIEF (SAVER) COURSE** a special service program undertaken by a group of Girl Scouts and non-Girl Scouts to enable them to assist in fact-finding, communication, referrals, relief-operations in times of disaster; to educate them on disaster risk reduction and management which they can make use of in their everyday lives.
 Note: Completion of this course is one of the requirements for CAT Exemption.
 For: Both Girls (Grade VI, Seniors, Cadets) and Adults (teachers or non-teachers, parents, Barangay and District Committee Members)
 Event Fee: Php1,200.00
3. **BASIC TRAINING and AGE LEVEL SPECIALIZATION** It aims to: educate on basics and understanding of Girl Scouting, its aims, ideals, program structure, policies and standards, ways of work. Stimulate the acceptance of the Girl Scout Promise and Law.
 For: Adults/Troop Leaders Php2,000.00

4. **OUTDOOR LEADERSHIP (OLC)** the participants should be able to have a good knowledge and demonstrate basic outdoor skills, plan, organize and run a Troop Camp.

For: Troop Leaders who have already taken the Basic Training
Event Fee: Php2,000.00


RECOGNITION : National Training Certificate for those who will complete the course.

This being an official business can be charged to MOOE/Local Funds subject to the standard accounting and auditing procedures.


