Regional Letter No. 347 s. 2016

Art of Recycling Contest
Chooga Comprehensive School Program
Contest Mechanics

Mechanics

1. The Contest is open to all Grade 1-6 pupils from public or private schools in NCR.
2. The students or group of students must create objects, material or equipment that they could be used in their daily lives in home or school, eg. bags, raincoat, hat, place mat, decors, toys, etc. artistically made up of empty Chooga Juice wrappers.
3. The artwork must be in 2-dimensional or 3-dimensional form, made out of 70% Chooga Juice wrappers; 30% of other materials such as paint, glue, wires, etc.
4. The students could do a collage, montage, sculpture, drawing, painting, mosaic, origami or a combination of the art forms to design and make their artwork entry.
5. The size of the entry should not be less than 18in and not more than 60in height and not less than 12in in width.
6. The entry should be done sturdy enough in such a way that it could be displayed and be used.
7. The theme of the contest is "Filipino Kid of Good Values Recycles".

How to Join/Who can join:

1. The contest is open to all Grade 1-6 pupils of both public and private schools.
2. Each entry must have an official entry form that must include the name of the students or group of students, home address/s phone numbers, school address, school's telephone number, adviser of student and title of the artwork.
3. All employees of Refreshment Republic Inc., its PR and advertising agencies, suppliers, relatives-up to 2nd degree of consanguinity and affinity are disqualified to join.

Selection

1. Each school may send as many entries as they want to their Division offices on or before the division finals on February 24, 2017.
2. Each division will choose the best 3 entries in the preliminary judging from March 3, 2017.
3. Marylindbert Int'l will pick up the finalists entries from the Division offices 2-3 days before the Regional Art of Recycling Contest.

4. Regional Finals will be on March 10, 2017 In Aguinaldo Elementary School, Murphy, Cubao, Quezon City
5. A panel of judges from the DepED NCR, MaryLindbert Int'l and Refreshment Republic Inc. will choose the winning entries.
6. Decision of the panel of judges is final.
7. All entries will be owned by Refreshment Republic Inc.

Criteria for Judging:

1. Within theme and mechanics -----30%
2. Craftsmanship -----30%
3. Originality -----20%
4. Creativity -----20 %
