



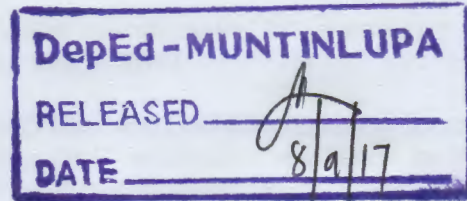



Schools are directed to reconstitute their School GFPS immediately and submit copy of the same to the SDO Attn: SDO GFPS Focal Person.

The functions of the GAD Focal Point Persons (GFPS) are stipulated in paragraph 3 of DepEd Order No. 27, s. 2013, and DepEd Memorandum No. 140, s. 2012.

All public schools are directed to prepare annual GAD Plan and budget to address gender issues and concerns. The GAD Plan shall be accompanied by GAD accomplishment report for the previous year. The amount to be allocated and utilized for the implementation of GAD PPAs shall be drawn from the 5% of School's MOOE for the year subject to COA audit policy guidelines.

Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
